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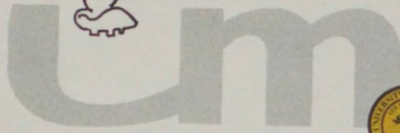
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CUBS PLAY THREE GAME SCHEDULE

The University of Montana will have a three game freshman football schedule in 1970. Reid Miller, Grizzly frosh coach, said he expects from 40 to 50 freshman to turn out for football Thursday when the team begins practice.

Miller said the Cubs will open the season on October 16 in Bozeman against the Montana State frosh team and will travel to Grangeville, Ida. on October 23 for a clash with the Boise State freshman unit.

The final game of the season is in Missoula at Dornblaser Stadium when the Cubs host the Bobkittens from MSU. October 30 is the date for that game.

Miller said the freshman team this season could be the best in the history of Montana. "We have 27 of the best football players in the Northwest on scholarship and I feel we are going to have a great season," Miller concluded.
