LESTER NAMED TO
'WHO'S WHO IN WEST'

MISSOULA--

John L. Lester, a University of Montana music professor who is acting dean of the UM School of Fine Arts, is listed in the 1970-71 edition of "Who's Who in the West," a biographical dictionary affiliated with "Who's Who in America."

Lester has been a member of the UM music faculty since 1939. He has served on the board of directors of the National Association of the Teachers of Singing, and as association regional governor for Washington, Idaho, Oregon, Wyoming and Montana.

Following his graduation in 1922 from Southwestern University, Georgetown, Tex., Lester studied in New York City, then spent several years abroad, studying in France, Italy and Germany.

Under Lester's direction, the UM Musical Theater group has prepared and performed programs throughout Montana.
