FOR UM QUINTET
AT HELLGATE H.S.

The University of Montana Woodwind Quintet will be featured in a musical performance at Hellgate High School, Missoula, Thursday (Oct. 22) during the state convention of the Montana Music Educators Association.

Convention dates are Oct. 21-24.

Works by such composers as Bach, Beethoven and Hindemith will be among the selections featured during Thursday's program, which begins at 3 p.m. at the high school.

The quintet is under the direction of Dr. Edwin Rosenkranz, an assistant professor of music at the University.

Quintet members include Sally Titland, Cut Bank, flute; Keneth W. Kirkpatrick, Missoula, clarinet; Elizabeth Anne Eitel, Missoula, oboe; John H. Hancock, Great Falls, French horn, and Klif W. Hodgkin, Missoula, bassoon. Assisting will be Eva Marian Maxwell, Missoula, pianoforte.

Works featured will include "Fugue in D minor" by Bach, "Quintet for Piano and Winds" by Beethoven, "Shanty for Wind Quintet" by Malcolm Arnold, a German selection by Hindemith and "Rengaines" by Andre Souris.
