**SYLLABUS - Fall 2001**

- I. Rehearsals:**                    **Tuesdays & Thursdays 4:45 - 5:45 p.m. Room 1.**
- A. Students are expected to come to all rehearsals thoroughly prepared.
  - B. Specific rehearsal schedules will be posted in advance on the bulletin board outside the band room. Check this schedule well in advance and be prepared for a productive rehearsal. Be prepared for every rehearsal!
  - C. There will be no food, drinks or chewing gum allowed in rehearsal.
- II. Attendance:**                    **Students are expected to attend all rehearsals.**
- A. If you must miss a rehearsal for any reason, you **must** call Mr. Bolstad in advance of the absence. If you are sharing music with another person, it is your responsibility to make sure that all music required for rehearsal is available to the stand partner.
  - B. If a rehearsal is missed, you must schedule an appointment with Mr. Bolstad or Mr. Haberman within one week following the absence for a coaching session on the performance material.
  - C. Unexcused absences will lower your grade. Absence from a performance will result in automatic failure.
