The Grizzly Camellia Bowl Committee has selected Debbie Morgan, a University of Montana junior from Helena, as a candidate for Camellia Bowl Queen competition in Sacramento, Calif., according to Col. Tom Davis, committee chairman.

Miss Morgan, 20, head cheerleader for the undefeated Grizzly football team, will travel to Sacramento on Dec. 9 to take part in activities which culminate with the tenth annual Camellia Bowl game on Dec. 12. The game pits UM against North Dakota State University for the NCAA West Region College Division championship.

Final judging of 14 queen candidates will take place during a Camellia Bowl Prevue party scheduled for 8 p.m., Dec. 11, in the Sacramento Inn. The queen and two princesses will participate in half-time activities on Saturday.

Hollywood screen and TV personalities will entertain at the party, which is expected to attract an attendance of 500, including Sacramento's leading business people and alumni and fans of UM and NDSU. Tickets are \$3.50 per person.

An elementary education major, Miss Morgan will be making her second appearance at the Camellia Bowl. She performed with the Grizzly cheerleaders at the 1969 contest which UM dropped to NDSU, 30-3. Earlier last year she reigned as UM Military Ball Queen.

Miss Morgan is the daughter of Dr. and Mrs. R.M. Morgan of Helena. Mrs. Morgan, the former Rene Rouleau, is a UM graduate. Another daughter, Robin, a UM sophomore, also will be at the Camellia Bowl with the Grizzly cheerleaders.
