Mrs. Julie Betty is the new foreign student adviser at the University of Montana.

She replaces George Cross, still assistant dean of students at UM, who formerly held the foreign student advisory post.

Mrs. Betty started working in her new capacity in November.

She received her Bachelor of Arts degree in history and German from Kalamazoo College, Kalamazoo, Mich., and attended the University of Michigan in Ann Arbor on a Rackham Fellowship and earned her master's degree in guidance and counseling there. While at Michigan, Mrs. Betty worked with foreign students as part of her training curriculum.

Concerning her new post at Montana, Mrs. Betty said, "I want to become personally acquainted with as many foreign students as I can. I am the only foreign student adviser on campus and I want to help with any problems or questions they may have, including information about visas, vacation plans and so on. I am here to cover the whole scope of problems encountered by foreign students."

Regarding Mrs. Betty's appointment as foreign students' adviser, Dr. Robert R. Fedore, UM dean of students, said, "We're certainly pleased to have a person with Mrs. Betty's talents. She comes to us with fine experience. I feel we're very fortunate to have a person of her capabilities with us."

Mrs. Betty also works on student programs out of the dean's office, according to Dr. Fedore.
