ESTHER ENGLAND NAMED CHAIRMAN
OF YOUNG ARTIST AUDITIONS

MISSOULA--

Esther England, a visiting instructor in music at the University of Montana, has been appointed chairman of the Young Artist Auditions of the Montana Federation of Music Clubs, replacing Dr. Luther A. Richman, who has retired.

Miss England, a native of McCall, Idaho, received her Bachelor of Arts degree in music with high honors at UM in 1966. In 1965 she was a winner in the regional Metropolitan Opera Auditions and after graduation at UM she went to Munich, Germany, where she studied music under a Fulbright Honor Scholarship.

In 1969 Miss England returned to Missoula to teach voice in the UM music department. Besides her duties as voice instructor she also is assistant director of the Opera Workshop and is a member of the Opera Quintet.

Miss England is a member of Alpha Lambda Delta freshman honorary, Phi Kappa Phi national scholastic honorary and Pi Kappa Lambda music honorary.
