UM STUDENTS MAY APPLY FOR
NATIONAL EXCHANGE PROGRAM

Feb. 17 is the deadline for applications for the National Student Exchange, according to Marilyn Parker, coordinator of the program at the University of Montana.

The National Student Exchange is a cooperative program among 54 state colleges and universities in 33 states. Since its inception in 1968, more than 6,500 students have taken part. The program offers participants a chance for exploration of new geographical settings, academic diversification and cultural awareness.

Under the program, eligible students spend the sophomore or junior year at another school. They pay tuition at the home school or in-state tuition at the host school.
