INTERNATIONAL STUDENT ASSOCIATION SPONSORS LECTURES

MISSOULA--

Jacob Ting, a graduate student in microbiology, will give the first in a series of three lectures sponsored by the International Student Association of the University of Montana. He will speak Thursday, Jan. 29, at 7p.m. in the University Center Lounge on the UM campus.

The topic of Ting's lecture will be "Parasites- Why Know About Them?" He will focus on species most commonly encountered in international travel.

Ting is a student from Hong Kong and is president of the International Student Association. He obtained an undergraduate degree in zoology from the UM.

The second lecture will be Thursday, Feb. 19, also at 7p.m. in the UC Lounge. Steve Hartman will show slides taken during six months in Antarctica.

On Thursday, Feb. 26, J.J. Ferraroni will discuss health problems in the tropics. Ferraroni, a physician and candidate for the Ph.D. in microbiology at the UM, recently gave a presentation at the 10th International Congress of Tropical Medicine and Malaria in Manila.
