GRIZZLY TRACKSTERS TRAVEL TO MOSCOW

MISSOULA --

After some outstanding performances in meets last week, the University of Montana track team will travel to Moscow, Idaho for the University of Idaho-hosted, 6th Annual Vandal Indoor, Feb. 7.

Last week UM's Jan Harland, a freshman from The Hague, Holland set an Eastern Washington field house record in the 60-meter hurdles, with a time of 7.8. He also won the long jump competition with a leap of 23-3. He was runnerup in the 60-meter dash in a time of 6.7 seconds and third in the pole vault at 15-0.

Also in the EWU meet, Grizzly freshman Dave Susanj went 14-6 in the pole vault.

Several of coach Larry Heidebrecht's squad also competed at Montana State's dual, non-scoring meet last Saturday in Bozeman.

Leading the way was senior Dale Giem who set a Brick Breeden Field House record in the 400 meters in a time of 49.2. The 1600-meter relay team of Giem, Rusty Weaver, Guy Rogers and Kevin Paulsen also established a field house standard with a time of 3:23.9. UM's Vince Martin was second in the triple jump at 45-1½ and third in the long jump with a distance of 21-1 3/4.

The Grizzlies are preparing for the upcoming Big Sky Conference indoor championships, scheduled for Feb. 27-28 in Pocatello, Idaho.

Thus far this season Giem is the only UM athlete to qualify for the nationals. He qualified in the 500 meters. The nationals are March 13-14 in Detroit.
