### UM ARTISTS ON DISPLAY

MISSOULA--

Three professors and two visiting professors in the art department at the University of Montana have been busy lately with art exhibitions and publications. The artists are involved in exhibits throughout the state of Montana and one artist is giving workshops in all parts of the United States.

Rudy Autio, professor of art, conducted workshops at the Community Arts Center in El Paso, Tex., from Feb. 6 to Feb. 8 and is presently conducting a ceramics workshop at the University of Indiana, Terre Haute, until Feb. 27. Autio also had a stoneware piece, "Double Lady Vessel," published in Art in America in January and was the featured subject of an article in the Oct.- Nov. 1980 issue of American Crafts magazine.

James Todd, chairman of the art department, has had two of his wood engraved prints, "Fly Buddha II" and "Mute," published in Rendevous, University of Idaho press, and has an exhibition of paintings, drawings and prints at the Black Orchid Gallery in Butte from Feb. 7 to March 14.

Professor Donald Bunse has had his collagraph print "Autobiography a'la Carte" published in the book The Complete Collagraph.

Dennis Voss, assistant visiting professor, had an exhibition at Montana State University, Bozeman, in December 1980 and has an exhibit at the Yellowstone Art Auction Exhibition at the Yellowstone Art Center in Billings during the month of February.

Voss has also been appointed to the "Panel for Artists in Education" by the National Endowment for the Arts in Washington, D.C. The panel is made up of 14 people from throughout the United States and meets in Washington, D.C., three times a year to deal with policy and allocation of funding for all 50 states and six territories. The appointment can last up to three years.

Mary Ann Kelly, assistant visiting professor, is exhibiting her paintings at the Danforth Gallery in Livingston from Feb. 23 to March 20.
