### UM OFFERS CALLIGRAPHY CLASS

An introductory course in calligraphy, the art of beautiful writing, will be offered at the University of Montana spring quarter on Tuesdays from 7 to 9 p.m. starting April 7. The class will meet in Botany 208.

Annie Cicale will teach the course designed for artists, graphic artists and classroom teachers of handwriting. The italic alphabet will be studied, using an analytical approach to understand the ideal form. Discussions will include handwriting programs, historical development of the alphabet and commercial applications of calligraphy. The class will combine lectures and practice.

The course carries two credits in Art 395 and costs \$60 plus supplies. Registration will be completed at the first class meeting. Further information is available from the Center for Continuing Education, 125 Main Hall on campus, telephone 243-2900.
