### ARCHAEOLOGIST TO GIVE LECTURES

Dr. George Rapp Jr. will present two free lectures at the University of Montana on Tuesday, April 28, as part of a national lecture program sponsored by Sigma Xi, the Scientific Research Society.

Rapp will speak on archaeological geology at 4 p.m. in room 304 of the Science Complex. He will give a lecture titled "The Geological Origin of the Atlantis Legend" at 7:30 p.m. in room 215 of the Women's Center.

Rapp is dean of the College of Letters and Science, professor of geology and archaeology, and director of the Archaeometry Laboratory at the University of Minnesota, Duluth. He served as associate director of the Minnesota Messenia Expedition and Nichoria Excavation and is now archaeometric director of the Tel Mikhal Excavation. He is president of the Association for Field Archaeology, past chairman of the Division of Archaeological Geology of the Geological Society of America, and co-founder fo the Center for Ancient Studies at the University of Minnesota.
