FLUTISTS TO PERFORM AT UM GALLERY OF VISUAL ARTS

Debra Shorrock, assistant professor of music at the University of Montana, and guest artist Jeff Cohan will be featured in duets and solos in a flute recital in the Gallery of Visual Arts in the UM Social Sciences Building Sunday, May 10, at 3 p.m. The recital is open to the public without charge.

The program includes works by Telemann, Mozart, W. F. Bach, Kahlau, Hohvaness and Hindemith.

Cohan, a virtuoso on both the modern and the baroque flute, has appeared in solo recitals and with orchestras in the United States and Europe. He won the New York Music Club Young Artists' Competition in 1975 and the Erwin Bodky Award for Early Music Performance in 1977. He has held grants from the Martha Baird Rockefeller Fund, the French government and the Rockefeller Foundation.

He holds degrees from the University of Washington, Seattle, and a master of music degree from State University of New York, Stony Brook. His flute teachers have included Samuel Baron, Michael Debost, Maxence Larrieu and Felix Skowronek.

Shorrock has also studied flute with Skowronek as well as with Julius Baker and Sid Zeitlin. She earned a bachelor's degree at the University of

Washington and a master's degree from the University of New Hampshire and has taught at both those institutions as well as at Ohio University and Phillips Exeter Academy, Exeter, N. H.

She is a member of the Montana Woodwind Quintet and the Montana Baroque Ensemble, both UM faculty groups. She is principal flutist with the Missoula Symphony Orchestra.
