UM TO OFFER PUBLIC ADMINISTRATION PROGRAM

MISSOULA--

The University of Montana will offer a summer program in Public Administration June 22-July 17. The interdisciplinary program is based on a community studies theme and involves the Departments of Political Science, Geography, Economics and Sociology.

The program is designed to meet the educational needs of undergraduates and graduate students with public-service career goals, current governmental employees and social studies teachers. Courses focus on urban and rural sociology, local government administration and environmental administration.

Featured in this summer's program is "Public Administration," a four-credit class taught through the political science department. The course is designed for undergraduate and graduate students who are interested in governmental or public-service jobs.

Peter Koehn, associate professor of political science at UM, will teach the course. Koehn has served as a governmental consultant in the United States and foreign countries. He will highlight the dynamics of the organization and processes of public management.

Also to be given June 22-July 17 is "Human Geography" (3 credits) which will be taught by Evan Denney, chairman of the geography department and "Introduction to Complex Organizations" (4 credits) taught by William Evans of the sociology department.
