UM CHORAL CONDUCTORS WILL GIVE SEMINAR IN MILES CITY

MISSOULA--

June 16 is the deadline for pre-registration for a choral reading seminar scheduled in Miles City June 21-23.

The seminar for choral conductors, music educators and college students is sponsored by the American Choral Directors Association and the University of Montana.

The instructors are Donald Simmons, chairman of the UM music department and conductor of the Collegiate Chorale at the UM, and Donald Carey, conductor of the University Choir and the UM Chamber Chorale.

Participants will read and study the choral repertoire for treble, male and mixed chorus from elementary school through adult choruses.

The seminar will meet at Miles Community College Sunday, June 21, from 1 to 5 p.m. and from 7 to 9 p.m., and Monday and Tuesday, June 22 and 23, from 9 a.m. to noon and from 1 to 5 p.m.

The seminar offers two UM graduate credits in Music 505. The fee is \$60. Pre-registration forms should be obtained from and returned to the Center for Continuing Education, 125 Main Hall, University of Montana, Missoula 59812; telephone 243-2900.
