TWO UM WOMEN RECEIVE RECTOR SCHOLARSHIPS

MISSOULA--

Two University of Montana students, Kathy Irigoien, Culbertson, and Darla Heil, Seeley Lake, have received \$750 Olive M. Rector Scholarships for 1981-82.

Irigoien, a senior in political science and pre-law, is a member of UM Advocates, a student service organization which recruits and orients new students and acts as official University host. She is married to Thomas Irigoien of Lambert. She is the daughter of Bert and Therese Bidergaray of Culbertson and was 1978 valedictorian of Culbertson High School.

Heil, a junior in geology, also has won several other academic awards at UM. Heil, daughter of Harold and Alvina Heil of Rapid City, S.D., was the valedictorian of the New Underwood High School class of 1971. She attended the University of South Dakota, Vermillion, in 1971-72. She moved to Seeley Lake in 1976 and enrolled at UM in 1977.

The Olive M. Rector Scholarship is awarded to deserving Montana women at UM in memory of Olive M. Rector and was established by her daughters Dot Rector of Great Falls and Ann Rector Williams of Arnold, Calif.

The scholarship is given from the more than \$150,000 in undergraduate scholarships funded by the UM Foundation. Founded in 1952, the UM Foundation has become the principal source of academic scholarship funds for the university, providing scholarships in virtually every discipline.

Many of the scholarships are offered in honor of deceased alumni, parents or friends as well as to other distinguished Montanans and supporters of higher education.
