CLANCY GORDON SCHOLARSHIP FUND ESTABLISHED IN UM FOUNDATION

MISSOULA--

An endowed scholarship to aid University of Montana graduate students who have demonstrated ability and effectiveness in working on environmental problems has been established in the UM Foundation as a living memorial to Clarence C. "Clancy" Gordon, UM botanist and environmentalist, who died July 12.

Students from the biological, physical and social sciences as well as environmental studies will be eligible to apply for scholarships. Recipients will be selected by a campus committee composed of Sherman Preece, botany; Thomas Powers, economics; Philip Tourangeau, botany environmental studies laboratory; Ron Erickson, environmental studies program; Arnold Silverman, geology; and Les Pengelly, wild-life biology.

According to the committee, "Through this program, it is expected that new generations of students will have Clancy's concern for quality environment for all and, as Clancy Gordon Environmental Scholars, carry on his work."
