### UM EDUCATION COURSE OFFERED IN EUREKA

MISSOULA--

A mathematics course for teachers, with graduate credit available from the University of Montana, will be offered in Eureka on Sept. 17 and 18 in the Elementary Media Center. "Advanced Drill Activities through a Mathematics Lab and Problem Solving" will be taught by Dr. Lee VonKuster, associate professor of education at UM.

The class costs \$30 and will meet from 7 to 9 p.m. on Thursday, Sept. 17, and in the late afternoon and evening on Friday, Sept. 18. Specific times will be announced at the first class meeting.

Course content will include instruction on how to teach the four basic operations and problem solving. Several commercial materials, as well as student constructed materials, will be used.
