ORIGINAL PRINTS GO ON EXHIBIT
AT UNIVERSITY CENTER OCTOBER 15

Original signed prints of 12 outstanding contemporary artists will be on exhibit Oct. 15 through Nov. 13 in the University of Montana Center Art Gallery.

The prints, a traveling exhibit courtesy of the Arkansas Arts Center, titled "The Meyer Shapiro Portfolio," will include works of Frank Stella, Saul Steinburg, Jasper Johns, Alexander Liberman and Andy Warhol among others.

The portfolio was created and sold to raise funds for an endowed chair at Columbia University in New York City in honor of Meyer Shapiro, an American art historian and critic.

A reception with refreshments will open the exhibit at 7 p.m. Thursday, Oct. 15, in the gallery located in the University Center second floor lounge. Gallery hours are 8 a.m. to 8 p.m. weekdays.
