MUSIC PROFESSOR PRESENTS PROGRAM

William Manning, professor of music at the University of Montana, will present a clarinet recital on Tuesday, Oct. 20. The recital will begin at 8 p.m. in the Music Recital Hall.

Manning will be joined by pianist Phillip Clarke, assistant professor, and cellist Fern Glass, assistant professor.

The free program will consist of Sonata for Clarinet and Piano by Francis Poulenc; Trio for Piano, Clarinet and Cello, opus 114, by Johannes Brahms; Concerto by Aaron Copland; and Variations sur un air de Pays d'Oc by Louis Cahuzac.

Manning teaches clarinet and music theory at the UM where he has been a faculty member since 1957. He is principal clarinetist with the Missoula Symphony Orchestra and clarinetist with the Montana Woodwind Quintet, a resident faculty ensemble. He has appeared as guest soloist, instructor and adjudicator throughout Montana.
