UM COURSE ON THE GIFTED STUDENT OFFERED LOCALLY

MISSOULA--

The University of Montana Center for Continuing Education will offer a course Oct. 28 - Jan. 13 in Kalispell on "Developing Self-Awareness Skills with Gifted/Talented Students." Classes will meet on Wednesdays from 6 to 10 p.m. the first three weeks and from 8 to 10 p.m. the last eight weeks in the Peterson School Cottage, 2nd St. West and Meridian.

Students may earn from 1 to 3 undergraduate credits from UM in Education 395. Cost of the course is \$30 per credit.

The course is directed at developing and understanding the characteristics and psychological/social needs of the gifted student and how those needs can be addressed utilizing group process techniques.

Instructors will be Gail Hanninen, gifted/talented coordinator, and Donald Burtch, elementary guidance counselor, both of Kalispell School District V; and Mitzi Cline Vranish of Family Health Care in Kalispell.
