FOR RHODES SCHOLARSHIPS FOR WOMEN

MISSOULA--

A fellowship to attend St. Hilda's College, Oxford University, England, for two academic years beginning Oct. 1, 1982, has been made available by the Rhodes Trustees, according to Thomas P. Huff, chairman of the University of Montana philosophy department. Applications are due by Jan. 31.

Applications are invited from women in the United States and Canada under the age of 35 who are of postdoctoral status (or close to it) or who have comparable academic standing.

The fellowship recipient will be required to undertake research in a subject that can profitably be studied at Oxford, and may also be asked to do a limited amount of teaching. She will receive free board and lodging except during brief vacation periods. A house will be available if she is accompanied by her husband and/or family. Travel expense will be reimbursed.

In exceptional circumstances an application for a one-year fellowship may be considered.

Applications should be addressed to: The Principal, St. Hilda's College, Oxford, OX4 IDY, England. They must be received not later than Jan. 31, 1982. The application consists of a statement of the applicant's qualifications, a brief outline of the research she proposes to undertake, and the names of three persons prepared to act as academic referees.

Strong contenders for the fellowship will be invited to Oxford, at the expense of the Rhodes Trust, for interviews in late April or early May.
