GRADUATE TROMBONE RECITAL SCHEDULED AT UM

Larry Cragwick will present his graduate trombone recital on Friday, Jan. 22, at 8 p.m. in the Music Recital Hall on the UM campus.

Cragwick will be joined by Anita Rodin, playing piano and organ; oboist Roger McDonald; and the UM Brass Quintet.

The free program will include Five Duets for Oboe and Trombone by William Presser; Sonata by Donald H. White; and Arioso from Piano Concerto in F Minor by J.S. Bach.

Cragwick has done graduate work at the University of Northern Colorado, where he studied with Buddy Baker. He is a candidate for the master's degree at the University of Montana, where he studied with Lance Boyd, assistant professor of music.

Cragwick is presently working as a band director in Butte's elementary schools.
