SCULPTURE EXHIBIT AT UM
JAN. 24 TO FEB. 12

An exhibit of graphics and of metal, ceramic and mixed media sculpture by two University of Montana art graduates will be on display at the UM University Center Gallery from Jan. 24 to Feb. 12.

Titled "Eye to Eye," the exhibit is a collaboration between Jace Laakso, who earned a bachelor of arts degree last year, and Nanda Dagostino, a master of fine arts graduate. The artists work with elemental materials, emphasizing organic influences.

Laakso, an employee at KUFM radio at UM, also has a private metal sculpture studio in Missoula, and D'Agostino teaches art at Sussex Elementary School.

A free reception will be open to the public at 7 p.m. Jan. 24. The artists will discuss their work and answer questions about it. Refreshments will be provided.

Gallery hours are 8 a.m. to 8 p.m. weekdays.
