UM WORKSHOP IN NON-VERBAL COMMUNICATION OFFERED IN POLSON

MISSOULA--

A University of Montana workshop on non-verbal communication will be presented March 11-14 in the Polson Middle School Library, 111 4th Ave. East. Cost of the course is \$60 and participants can earn two undergraduate or graduate credits in Education 494 or Communication 490. Pre-registration is required by March 1.

The class will meet from 4 to 9 p.m. on Thursday, March 11, and Friday, March 12; from 9 to 4 p.m. on Saturday, March 13; and from 9 a.m. to noon on Sunday, March 14.

Dr. Fred Weldon, UM director of student affairs and a UM faculty member, will be the instructor.

The class will demonstrate how individuals are constantly transmitting information about themselves vocally, verbally and visually, and will try to create an awareness of the many meanings that lie beyond words.
