STOLTZMAN AND DOUGLAS TO PERFORM AT UM

Richard Stoltzman, clarinetist, and Bill Douglas, pianist, bassoonist and composer, will present an evening of classics and jazz improvisations Tuesday, April 13, at 8 p.m. in the University Theater at the University of Montana.

Stoltzman and Douglas met as graduate students at Yale and later served as faculty members at the California Institute of the Arts in the early 1970s. They have performed together in situations from parks to dormitories.

Currently they are working on baroque transcriptions in addition to classical, romantic and contemporary literature for clarinet and piano. They often perform Douglas' rhythmic etudes, which include improvisation, be-bop and scat singing. They also do improvisations to slides of wilderness scenes photographed by John Pearson.
