FRENCH EXCHANGE STUDENTS SEEK FARM, RANCH SUMMER WORK

MISSOULA--

Ten agricultural school students from France, who will be coming to Montana this summer, are looking for Montana farm or ranch families for whom they can work for a month.

The students, who are between 16 and 18 years old, will be participating in the 10th annual informal exchange program between the University of Montana and UM's study abroad program centered in the Lycee Agricole et Viticole in Beaune, Burgundy, France.

According to Philip Lutes, associate professor of French at UM and 1982 director of the program, the exchange students will require only work, board and room and some friendly Montana hospitality.

The group members will be both girls and boys and they know a fair amount of English. Most will come from French farm families.
