### GUEST MUSICIAN TO GIVE CARILLON CONCERT

Fans of carillon music are invited to a free concert in the University of Montana oval on Memorial Day - Monday, May 31, - at 2 p.m.

Judson Maynard, professor of music at Texas Tech University, will play a variety of works, including his own arrangements of "Caprice Viennois," by Fritz Kreisler; Scott Joplin ragtime pieces; and American folk songs.

He will also play Fantasia in D minor, KV. 327, by Mozart, and "Suite for Carillon," a piece by Mary Jeanne van Appledorn which won first prize in the International Carillon Competition, Dijon, France, in 1980. The composer dedicated the work to Maynard.

Maynard received bachelor and master of music education degrees from UM and a Ph.D. from Indiana University. At Texas Tech, he teaches carillon, organ, harpsichord and theory.

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
