### RIVERFRONT SUMMER THEATER PUBLIC AUDITIONS SET

The University of Montana Drama/Dance Department announces that open public auditions for Riverfront Summer Theater will take place Wednesday, June 2, at 7:30 p.m. in the University Theater.

Riverfront Summer Theater, now in its second year, will present two musicals and one comedy in a big top tent in downtown Caras Park. The summer schedule is as follows: "Cabaret," to run July 7-11, and 13-18, is directed by Rolly Meinholtz. "Same Time Next Year," directed by James Kriley, will play July 21-26 and July 27-Aug. 1. The final show, "Li'l Abner," will run Aug. 4-8, 10-15, and 17-22, and is directed by Randy Bolton. Rehearsals will be held in the evenings.

Those wishing to audition for a role in either "Cabaret" or "Li'l Abner" should prepare a song and bring their music with them. A piano accompanist will be provided. Dance specialists are encouraged to audition and they need not prepare a dance audition piece.
