### UNIVERSITY APPOINTS BUDGET DIRECTOR

MISSOULA --

The University of Montana has named R. Kenneth Stolz to be its new budget director, according to Vice President for Fiscal Affairs Patricia Douglas. The appointment, contingent on approval by the Board of Regents, becomes effective August 16.

Stolz is presently assistant to the director for planning and control in the Kansas Division of Information Systems. Previously he was fiscal analyst in the Office of Institutional Research and Planning at the University of Kansas.

"Kenneth Stolz has excellent experience in both higher education and state government," said Douglas. "He also has a good background in data processing, and I'm confident he will be able to move the budget office toward computerization of many of its activities."

Stolz earned a bachelor's degree from the College of Idaho with a major in business administration and a minor in economics in 1971. Since then he has completed course work in economics, public finance and administration, and computer science at Boise State University and the University of Kansas. Before going to Kansas, Stolz worked as a policy planner for the Idaho Division of Budget, Policy, Planning and Coordination.

Stolz succeeds Richard Hulme, UM's budget director since 1979, who left the position to pursue full-time studies in accounting.

The Regents will consider Stolz's appointment at their June 28th meeting.
