AUDUBON SOCIETY CONFERENCE WILL BE AT UM BIOLOGICAL STATION AUGUST 16-22

MISSOULA--

Bird-watchers and conservationists from throughout the West will gather at Flathead Lake for a regional National Audubon Society conference Aug. 16-22.

The 1982 Rocky Mountain Regional Conference of the society will be conducted at the University of Montana Biological Station at Yellow Bay at Flathead Lake for seven days.

Theme for the conference is "Protecting Our Natural Heritage." The program will include addresses by the society's staff officers, discussion groups and workshops, all concentrating on air, water, public lands and wildlife issues.

Bald eagles, ospreys and pileated woodpeckers are frequently sighted in the Flathead Lake area.

Tours of the nearby area, including the lake, Glacier National Park, the National Bison Range and the Bob Marshall Wilderness Area, will be scheduled by the Flathead Audubon Society at nominal costs.

Cost of the conference varies according to lodging and meal plans although there is a fixed registration fee of \$10 for the entire program or \$3 per day.
