MATH STUDENTS AWARDED PRIZES

MISSOULA--

Several prizes for academic achievement have been awarded to students majoring in mathematics at the University of Montana. The Lennes Prize, established in the memory of mathematics professor N.J. Lennes, was awarded to three students on the basis of their performance on a competitive exam.

The students are David Collett, Stevensville, first-place tie, \$60; Duane Dedrickson, Libby, first-place tie, \$60; and Laurie Brock Collett, Helena, second place, \$30.

The McDonald Prize, new this year, was awarded to George Goodman, Williston, N.D., the mathematics department's "Outstanding Mathematics Student" of the year. The prize commemorates Marvin McDonald, a graduate student from Missoula, who lost his life in a climbing accident last summer.
