HEMODYNAMIC PRESSURE MONITORING SEMINAR SCHEDULED IN MISSOULA

MISSOULA--

A two-day seminar on hemodynamic pressure monitoring for health care professionals who work in critical care units will be held on Oct. 14 and 15 at St. Patrick Hospital, Missoula.

The course is offered through the Center for Continuing Education at the University of Montana and 15 hours of continuing education credit are available.

The registration fee is \$90 and the deadline for registration is Oct. 4.

Topics include analyzing wave forms, interpreting pressure changes and troubleshooting equipment problems.

AnnMarie Robichaud, a nationally known lecturer on the subject, will conduct the seminar. Robichaud has a master's degree in medical surgical nursing from the University of Virginia and is an adult nurse practitioner.
