SPECIAL PRICE DEADLINE FOR
UM COURSE IN YUCATAN IS SEPT. 30

MISSOULA--

In order to get a low airfare price for a special University of Montana ecology course in Mexico's Yucatan in January, interested persons need to make a deposit by Sept. 30.

The course, offered through the UM Biological Station and the UM Center for Continuing Education, will be from Jan. 4-14, 1983.

The special airfare deposit is \$350; rates will increase by several hundred dollars after Sept. 30. Total cost for the course, which includes UM tuition, hotel and airfare from Great Falls, is \$910.

Dr. Jack A. Stanford, director of the biological station will lead and teach the course, which will include six hours of lecture, specific outside readings and an eight day field trip to Cozumel Island and the Mexican Yucatan. Three graduate or undergraduate credits are offered.

The course will cover the ecologies and functions of Yucatan tropical rain forests and nearby coral reefs.
