### EXCELLENCE FUND FINAL WEEK CRITICAL

Paul Chumrau, University of Montana Excellence Fund chairman, announced today that the local 1982-83 campaign deadline has been set for Dec. 10.

"We are at about 85 percent of the \$66,500 goal," Chumrau said. "With a week left in the campaign, there are still 600 accounts for which we don't have reports. That means the week of Dec. 6 will be a very crucial one for the success of the drive."

The business community has been enthusiastic about the local Excellence Fund drive, now in its fourth year, Chumrau said. Their giving, he said, has been exceptional, especially considering local economic conditions.
