FORMER MISSOULIAN DEBUTS ON BROADWAY

Kathy Danzer, a former resident of Missoula who received a bachelor of fine arts degree from the University of Montana in 1976, has joined the cast of the Pulitzer Prize-winning Broadway play "Crimes of the Heart."

Danzer plays Meg Magrath in Beth Henley's comedy about the Magrath sisters of Hazelhurst, Miss. Winner of the New York Drama Critics Circle Award, the play is currently the only comedy playing on Broadway. It is directed by Melvin Bernhardt.

Danzer is a native of Helena and began acting in that city's Old Brewery Theater at the age of 12. She appeared in numerous roles there, including the title role in "Gypsy." She has also appeared at the Bigfork Playhouse and helped start the Fort Peck Theater. She was involved in several UM productions including "A Midsummer Night's Dream" and "One Flew Over the Cuckoo's Nest."

In addition to roles in off and off-off Broadway shows, Danzer has performed at the Lincoln Center and on television.
