The University of Montana Wind Ensemble will present a free concert on Tuesday, Nov. 30, at 8 p.m. in the Music Recital Hall.

The ensemble is directed by Thomas Cook, associate professor of music.

Works to be performed by the ensemble include "A Musical Toast" by Leonard Bernstein; "Scenes for Wind Instruments and Percussion" by Verne Reynolds; and March, Opus 99 by Serge Prokofieff.

The program will also include the UM Woodwind Quintet performing "Trois pieces breves" by Jacques Ibert; Quintet No. 3 in F Major by G. Cambini; and Sarabande et Allegro by Gabriel Grovlez, with Roger McDonald as oboe soloist.
