WRITING COURSE SCHEDULED FOR JANUARY IN KALISPELL

MISSOULA--

The University of Montana Center for Continuing Education has scheduled a course titled "Writing Across the Curriculum" for Jan. 28 from noon to 7 p.m. and Jan. 29 from 9 a.m. to 2:30 p.m. at the Flathead Valley Community College in Kalispell.

Pre-registration is required by Jan. 14. Cost for the one-credit course is \$30.

The course will include writing criteria, proofreading processes, assignments and focus, methods of scoring, response and commenting for teachers, peer-editing and workshop processes for college writers. Evaluation will be based on attendance and a special graded project.

Instructors are Professor Richard Adler from UM and Jack Campbell from Flathead Valley Community College.
