RONAN IS SITE OF UM COURSE ON
LEGAL BASIS OF PUBLIC EDUCATION

MISSOULA--

"Legal Basis of Public Education," a University of Montana Center for Continuing Education course, will be taught at the Kicking Horse Center in Ronan Jan. 12, 13, 26, 27 and Feb. 9, 10, 23, 24 from 6:30 to 10 p.m. One additional three-hour session in the UM Law Library is also scheduled.

Pre-registration and a \$30 deposit is required by Jan. 5. Total cost for the three-credit courses is \$90.

The course will focus on the legal concepts of education in the United States and legal implications of the concept of education as a state function. It will address legal problems affecting students, teachers, parents, administrators, and school board members. Attention will also be given to community college legislation.

Drs. John Hunt and Madgie Hunt from UM are the instructors.
