UM HOSTS MONTANA 'CLE & SKI'  
AT BIG SKY JAN. 18-21

MISSOULA--

"Significant Developments in Commercial Practice" will be the main topic of the annual Continuing Legal Education (CLE) in Montana Conference, coordinated by the University of Montana School of Law Jan. 18-21 at Big Sky.

The conference will cover details in bankruptcy, the U.S. Uniform Commercial Code and state and federal securities laws. Experts in these areas will deliver several seminar addresses designed for lawyers.

Titles of addresses include: "Impact of Bankruptcy on Small Businesses (including farm and ranch operations)," "Farm Products as Collateral Under the U.C.C.," "A Survey of the Basic Coverage of State and Federal Securities Laws," "Recent Developments in Federal Securities Laws," and "Recent Developments in State Securities Law."

The program is coordinated by Ronald C. Wyse, a UM law professor. It will provide 15 hours toward the continuing education requirements in several states.

Arrangements for lodging and ski lift tickets should be made directly with Big Sky of Montana reservations office, P.O. Box 1, Big Sky, MT 59715. Rooms and condominiums are available and group rates for lift tickets will be \$12 a day and \$9 for children.
