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FACULTY PIANO RECITAL SCHEDULED AT UM

Steven Hesla, assistant professor of music at the University of Montana, will present a free piano recital on Tuesday, Jan.25, at 8 p.m. in the Music Recital Hall.

Hesla was a faculty member at Western Michigan University before coming to the UM. He received degrees from Oberlin Conservatory of Music and the University of Illinois and participated in the Berkshire Music Festival at Tanglewood, Mass., as a scholarship student. There he studied with John Browning, Claude Frank, Earl Wild and Bela Nagy. He has also studied with Gyorgy Sebok in Oregon and Switzerland.

The program will consist of three Scarlatti sonatas; Sonata in E Major, Opus 109, by Beethoven; "Jeux. d'eau" by Ravel; Sechs Kleine Klavierstucke, Opus 19 by Schoenberg; and Barcarolle, Opus 60 by Chopin.

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
