### IRS TAX TAPES AVAILABLE AT UM

Two audio cassette tapes that tell how to fill out federal income tax forms are available at Instructional Materials Service at the University of Montana. The tapes were prepared by the Internal Revenue Service.

One tape gives line-by-line instructions for the IRS Form 1040 and Schedules A and B. These schedules are for itemizing deductions and reporting interest and dividend income. The other tape tells how to do Form 1040A and the new Form 1040EZ.

The 1040EZ is for taxpayers who are single, have no dependents, do not claim exemptions for either age or blindness, have a taxable income of less than \$50,000 and interest of less than \$400 with no dividend income, and who claim no tax credits. The 1040EZ has only 11 lines, and more than 20 million taxpayers are eligible to use it.

The cassettes may be used at IMS in the UM Social Sciences Building or they may be checked out. IMS will be open from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m. Monday through Friday and from 7 to 10 p.m. Monday through Thursday. For more information, call Linda Harris, 243-4070.
