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COURSE FOR NURSES SCHEDULED IN MISSOULA

"Basic Coronary Care Nursing," a five-day course for nurses who provide care for acute myocardial infarction patients, is scheduled March 14-18 from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m. at St. Patrick Hospital School of Nursing, Missoula.

The University of Montana Continuing Education Program sponsors the course, which costs \$145. The fee covers registration, study materials and coffee breaks, but not housing. Motel information will be sent to registrants with acknowledgment of enrollment.
