DIABETIC HEALTH-CARE SEMINAR SCHEDULED FOR LEWISTOWN

MISSOULA--

"Diabetic Control and Complications," a seminar for health-care professionals, is scheduled for Sunday, March 13, in Lewistown. The seminar will meet from 8:30 a.m. to 3:45 p.m. in the Central Montana Hospital Conference Room. Pre-registration is required before March 3 and costs \$30 or \$35 at the door.
