UM EDUCATION COURSE OFFERED IN BROWNING
MISSOULA--

The University of Montana Center for Continuing Education has scheduled an education course in Browning titled "Meeting the Needs of the Gifted and Talented Within the Classroom." The three-credit class will meet at the Browning High School Friday and Saturday, March 25 and 26, and the following Friday and Saturday, April 8 and 9, each day from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m.

Cost is \$90. Pre-registration and a \$30 deposit are required before March 18.

The class will focus on methods for enhancing the school experience for the child who may be gifted. Identification, program models, teaching strategies and a systematic approach to developing a program will be discussed.

Paula Crews Fascilla, Kalispell, a specialist in teaching gifted children, will teach the course.
