SCHOLARSHIPS AVAILABLE FOR UM DAYS STUDENTS

MISSOULA--

High school students could win hundreds of dollars in scholarships during UM Days April 11-13 at the University of Montana.

Freshman scholarships range from \$300 to \$600 and are based on scholastic rank and aptitude test scores. Fine arts scholarships of \$500 are available in art and drama/dance. Fine arts scholarships in music range from \$150 to \$600.

Over \$35,000 in freshman scholarships are available this year. Last year 85 students were awarded freshman scholarships during UM Days. Twenty-five students were awarded Fine Arts scholarships.

Students who wish to compete for scholarships at UM Days should see their school counselors.

Funds for freshman scholarships are provided by the UM Foundation Excellence Fund and three private endowments: the Andrew B. Hammond, Sadie H. Fox and Marie H. Wallace Scholarship Funds.
