COMPUTERS IN RESOURCE MANAGEMENT
TOPIC OF SEMINAR AT UM

MISSOULA--

A three-day computer seminar to address the expanding use of microcomputers in resource management is scheduled April 5-7 at the University of Montana. "Computers in Resource Management," sponsored by the UM Center for Continuing Education, the School of Forestry and the Department of Computer Science, will convene at 9 a.m. Tuesday, April 5, and adjourn at 3:30 p.m. Thursday, April 7.

Cost for the seminar is \$40. Enrollment is limited and pre-registration before March 15 is advised.

UM faculty members and USDA employees from various parts of the country will conduct sessions on such topics as hardware and software considerations; information processing and forestry inventory systems; growth, yield and forest management applications; and data management. Demonstrations of a variety of software and hardware applications systems will be held on Tuesday and Wednesday evenings.

A limited number of dormitory rooms on campus will be available for \$8 per night for single occupancy and \$6 per night for double occupancy. For dorm room reservations contact the Residence Halls Office, University of Montana, Missoula, MT 59812; 243-2611. Meals are available in University Center dining rooms at reasonable rates.
