STUDENT SCHOLARSHIPS TO FOREIGN NATIONS REOPENED

MISSOULA--

Graduating seniors and graduate students interested in doing research overseas next year have another chance to apply for Fulbright Scholarships.

According to Dr. Robert Acker, an associate professor of German and the Fulbright adviser at the University of Montana, competition for scholarships to 11 countries has reopened. Deadline for application is April 14.

Scholarships are available for Algeria, Bangladesh, Morocco, Nepal, Pakistan, Sri Lanka, Sudan, Tunisia, Malaysia, Singapore and Thailand.

Applicants should have a knowledge of the history, culture and current events of the countries to which they are applying. Research projects, which should be proposed with the applications, should be compatible with the facilities and courses of study available. While in the host country, the applicant must be affiliated with an educational institution.

The scholarships are open for the 1983-84 academic year. Applicants should be less than 32 years of age on July 1, 1984.
