CLAY AND METAL SCULPTURE
AT UC GALLERY MAY 2 - 14

Clay and metal sculptures by University of Montana graduate student Joyce Centofanti will be on exhibit at the University May 2-14.

The exhibit, titled "Motions," will be in the UM University Center Gallery, located in the second floor lounge.

The sculptures are clay pieces stacked on metal frames, which emphasizes the stability of the metal and fragility of the clay.

Centofanti is a master of fine arts candidate at UM. She received a bachelor of fine arts degree in ceramics from Mount St. Mary's College, Redondo Beach, Calif., in 1980. She won the 1982 Artists' Collective Award at UM.

A free public reception, with refreshments, will begin at 7 p.m. Monday, May 2, in the gallery.
